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1. Say your students' names often

- a. When class starts
- b. When taking roll
- c. Every time they share an idea

2. Give students lots of choices

- a. In where they sit
- b. On assignments
- c. In picking their groups

3. Talk to students throughout the day

- a. During class
- b. In the halls
- c. At lunch / after school

4. Let students assess you/your teaching often

- a. After class
- b. After a unit
- c. At the end of the quarter

5. Compliment and thank students often

- a. About their work/effort
- b. About their positive choices
- c. Thank them at the end of each class

6. Let students self-assess

- a. On assignments/tests
- b. On behavioral issues
- c. With their attitudes

7. Show your students that you trust them

- a. Self assessments
- b. Take home exams
- c. Bathroom policy

8. Include some "easy" days

- a. Fun review games
- b. Catch up days
- c. End of quarter celebrations
